## ACTIVE TRANSPORT TRACKER

Ask students to think about how they came to school today. Using the prepared table, students vote using a show of hands and the tallies are placed in the table. Repeat the same procedure to collect information on how they plan to get home today. This information can be used as part of the planning and evaluation process when implementing an Active Travel to School Plan

## **DISCUSS:**

- 1. What was the most popular way for children to come to and from school?
- 2. What was the least popular way?
- 3. What do you think are some reasons for this?
- 4. Who decides how students travel to and from school?
- 5. What sorts of things will decide how students travel to and from school e.g. weather, time, distance from school, bicycle riding skills, access to a bicycle and access to public transport?
