

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

PURPOSE

To provide the Environment Strategic Reference Group (SRG) with an update on a number of key documents, including those that will be considered by Council at its meeting of 27 August 2019.

REPORT

Environment & Climate Change Strategy

Staff have now finalized the draft Environment and Climate Change Strategy which will be reported to the 27 August Council meeting with a recommendation to place the Strategy on public exhibition. The Environment SRG have provided critical input to this process over the last 12 months. The strategy has now been published in its public exhibition format and this meeting provides a final opportunity for members to discuss any recommendations to Council.

Climate Change Action Plan

As members would recall, the Strategy will be supported by 11 Action Plans. The Environment SRG has consistently raised action on Climate Change as being of significant importance, and such, staff commenced work on the development of a Climate Change Action Plan. The first draft of this document has been completed, and a briefing will be provided to the SRG to discuss status and next steps.

Barriers to Solar Uptake

In addition, staff have also completed their report into barriers that the community are experiencing inputting solar into their homes. This report will also be presented to the 27 August Council meeting, and staff will brief the SRG on their findings and likely recommendations to Council.

Bushland & Biodiversity Policy

Finally, staff have taken the recent feedback from the Environment SRG and completed the draft Bushland and Biodiversity Policy. The draft Policy will also be presented to the 27 August Council meeting and staff will provide an update on the key recommendations to Council.
