REPORT

BACKGROUND

The Roads and Maritime Services (RMS), as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital Roadworks, upgraded Frenchs Forest Road East including the intersection of Frenchs Forest Road East and Patanga Road. During the upgrade, it was determined that the right turn out of Patanga Road onto Frenchs Forest Road East would be restricted to buses and garbage trucks to minimise the impact on traffic flow in the local network.

RMS has received significant community and business owner representation to allow general traffic out of Patanga Road since the implementation of the new traffic signals at Frenchs Forest Roads East and Patanga Road.

RMS has also received a request from the office of Mr Brad Hazzard (Member of Wakehurst) to convert the existing loading zone and mail zone to parking.

LOCATION

Frenchs Forest Road East is a local road with two lanes in each direction to the west of Patanga Road. It carries medium volumes of traffic and connects Forest Way to Warringah Road/Allambie Road.

Patanga Road is a local road carrying low volumes of two way traffic, but only allows one-way traffic to turn right out at the signalised intersection with Frenchs Forest Road East.

ISSUES

- General traffic is not permitted to use Patanga Road to exit onto Frenchs Forest Road
- Lack of parking within close proximity to shops

PROPOSAL

The RMS has assessed the impact of changing the traffic arrangement at the intersection, and modelling has indicated that allowing general traffic to turn right out of Patanga Road has minimal impact during the off peak. The RMS proposes allowing the right turn out of Patanga Road:

- Monday to Friday, outside the hours of 6:00am 10:00am / 3:00pm 7:00pm
- Saturday and Sunday (all day)


 Cyclist will be permitted to use the Patanga Road signal approach to enter Frenchs Forest Road East during off peak hours
