Consideration of Application		
The proposal seeks consent for the modification of an approved application for landscaping works. The proposal includes changes that extend into the heritage item. The proposal includes the retention of existing natural rock boulders and the construction and extension of sandstone		

retaining walls along the foreshore. Heritage has considered the proposal and views the retention of the boulders as beneficial to the heritage listing and the proposed sandstone seawall as an appropriate way to maintain the item's significance.

Therefore Heritage raises no objections subject to a condition that the boulders along the water's edge be retained over the life of the development.
