4.0 REPORTS FOR APPROVAL BY COUNCIL DELEGATION

4.1 VICTOR ROAD, DEE WHY - PEDESTRIAN REFUGE ISLAND

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The representative from Transport for NSW requested the detailed design be provided to TfNSW for review and concurrence. Note that the No Stopping line marking may need to be extended if a 3m gap cannot be achieved with parking where the BB line is proposed.

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

- A. Installation of 4P 8:00AM-4:00PM SAT & SUN Timed Parking restrictions on the western side of Victor Road, Dee Why, along the frontage of Beverley Job Park.
- B. Installation of Dividing Separation Lines on Victor Road, Dee Why, between the intersections with Redman Road and McIntosh Road.
- C. Installation of a Pedestrian Refuge adjacent to the intersection of Victor Road and Lewis Street, Dee Why.
- D. Detailed plan of the Pedestrian Refuge to be prepared and submitted to TfNSW for approval.



4.2 WEST ESPLANADE & COMMONWEALTH PARADE, MANLY - SPEED CUSHIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The representative from Transport for NSW noted that the staff should ensure adequate street lighting to maximise visibility. TfNSW recommends placing the westbound road cushion further east to improve sight distance for approaching vehicles, and enquired about the height of the proposed cushion. No objection – plan to be shown prior to installation.

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

- A. Introduction of speed cushions on the approaches to the existing pedestrian refuge sited on Commonwealth Parade at its intersection with West Esplanade
- B. The detailed design plan be forwarded to TfNSW prior to construction for concurrence.

4.3 GOURLAY AVENUE, BALGOWLAH - NO STOPPING

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

A. Introduction of approximately 155m of unbroken yellow No Stopping line on the east side of Gourlay Avenue, Balgowlah between New Street and the 90 degree bend where it meets the Spit to Manly Walk



4.4 BROOK ROAD, SEAFORTH - NO STOPPING

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

A. Removal of No Parking and replacement with full time No Stopping restrictions on either side of Brook Road on the immediate approaches to the pram ramps providing access to and from Seaforth Public School.

4.5 CAMPBELL PARADE & QUIRK ROAD, MANLY VALE - SCHOOL PARKING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The representative from Transport for NSW noted that staff are to ensure relevant No Stopping distances are met for pedestrian crossing – No objection.

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports:

- A. The introduction of No Parking Motor Vehicles Excepted parking restriction on both sides of Campbell Parade between the cul-de-sac and Passmore Reserve
- B. The introduction of a short length of No Parking (8am 9am & 2:30pm-4pm School Days) on the south side of Campbell Parade between existing school bus stops and the existing raised threshold device at the eastern end of the school frontage
- C. The existing AM peak Bus Zone on the south side of Campbell Parade in front of the school hall and admin building changing to AM peak No Parking Zone
- D. The existing AM peak No Parking zone immediately east of Quirk Road changing to AM peak Bus Zone
- E. The 5min parking zone (8am 9am & 2:30pm-4pm School Days) on the north side of Campbell Parade increasing from 9 bays to 15 bays
- F. The introduction of 8P parking applying 9am to 7pm throughout the balance of the 90-degree parking area on the north side of Campbell Parade
- G. Changing the existing No Parking (7-9am & 3-4pm School Days) to No Stopping (7-9am & 3-4pm School Days) on the north side of Campbell Parade west of Quirk Road
- H. Installing a Bus Zone (8-9:30am & 2:30-4pm School Days) to support the existing Bus Stop on the west side of Quirk Road near Campbell Parade
- I. Installing approximately 12m of No Parking (8am 9am & 2:30pm-4pm School Days) on the east side of Quirk Road south of the school's staff carpark



4.6 JENNER STREET, SEAFORTH - NO STOPPING

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

- A. Replacement of the existing No Parking restriction in front of No's 7 & 9 Jenner Street with an unbroken yellow No Stopping line
- B. Installation of an unbroken yellow No Stopping line on the north side of Jenner Street between the driveways serving No.14 & 20 Jenner Street
- C. Installation of unbroken yellow No Stopping lines on both sides of Munoora Street adjacent to the existing unbroken dividing lines between Jenner Street and Grandview Grove

Council Decision – Approved

4.7 TAREE AVENUE & URUNGA STREET, NORTH BALGOWLAH - BUS ZONE & NO PARKING

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

- A. Introduction of unbroken yellow No Stopping line on the inside radius of the bend where Taree Avenue meets Urunga Street. The line to extend between the driveway on the Urunga Street frontage of No.2 Urunga Street and a point 6m south of the driveway serving No.2 Urunga Street on its Taree Avenue frontage
- B. Introduction unbroken yellow No Stopping line on the inside radius of the bend where Taree Avenue meets Moramba Street. The line to extend between the driveway to No.7 Taree Avenue and a point 10m east of the Taree Avenue kerb alignment into Moramba Street
- C. Introduction of approximately 17m of No Parking restriction on the east side of Taree Avenue commencing 6m south of the driveway serving No. 11 Taree Avenue
- D. Introduction of a 30m length of Bus Zone on the south side of Urunga Street to support the existing bus stop



4.8 UPPER CLONTARF STREET, NORTH BALGOWLAH - 8P PARKING AREA

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the introduction of an 8P Parking Area applying 8AM to 6PM Everyday within the parking area at the northern end of Upper Clontarf Street

Council Decision - Approved

4.9 ALFRED ROAD, BROOKVALE - NO PARKING

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

A. Creation of a 37m length of No Parking on the west side of Alfred Road between Gulliver Street and the No Stopping zone on approach to the existing Wombat crossing. The No Parking restriction to apply 8am to 9am and 3pm to 4pm School Days



4.10 BUNGAN HEAD, NEWPORT - NO STOPPING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the following proposals in Bungan Head Road, Newport:

- A. Extension of the existing 'No Stopping' restrictions from north of the driveway of No.53 to the driveway of No.63.
- B. Installation of 'No Stopping' restrictions between the driveways of No.72 and No.82.

4.11 AQUATIC DRIVE, ALLAMBIE HEIGHTS - TIMED PARKING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the introduction of:

A. Timed Parking 6P 7:00am – 7:00pm Everyday restrictions along sections of the northern and southern side of Aquatic Drive between Allambie Road and Madison Way per attached plan.



4.12 BEACON HILL ROAD, BROOKVALE - NO STOPPING RESTRICTION

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the introduction of:

A. A No Stopping Unbroken Yellow Kerb Line from the existing statutory No Stopping restrictions at the intersection of Consul Road and Beacon Hill Road, approximately 51m to the existing statutory No Stopping restrictions at the intersection of Beacon Hill Road and Elizabeth Place, Brookvale.

4.13 CROSS STREET, BROOKVALE - PAINTED TRAFFIC ISLAND

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the introduction of a:

A. Painted traffic island in between the driveways No.24 and No.26 Cross Street, Brookvale.



4.14 GREEN STREET, BROOKVALE - NO STOPPING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the introduction of:

A. An amendment to the existing No Stopping restrictions to No Stopping Australia Post Vehicles Excepted and maintain the remainder of the No Stopping restrictions on the western side of Green Street, outside Green Street Reserve, Brookvale.

4.15 FOAMCREST AVENUE, NEWPORT - CARPARK - TIMED PARKING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

A. Installation of '1/2P 8AM – 6PM MON – FRI and 8AM – 1PM SAT' in the nine spaces on the eastern side of the carpark.



4.16 RIVERVIEW ROAD, AVALON BEACH - NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

Approved by exception.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

- A. Replacement of existing 'No Parking 7AM 5PM EVERYDAY' with 'No Parking'
- B. Relocation of 'No Parking' (L) and 'Bus Zone' (R) to northern side of driveway at 11 Riverview Road
- C. Install 'No Parking' from existing 'Bus Zone' to Paradise Avenue
- D. Extend double barrier line approx. 5m to be adjacent with property boundary at 2 & 4 Riverview Road

4.17 LOQUAT VALLEY ROAD, BAYVIEW - NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

A. The installation of a No Parking Zone 5m from the property of No.32 Loquat Valley Road, Bayview



4.18 ALFRED STREET, NARAWEEENA - THRESHOLD TREATMENT

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The representative from Transport for NSW raised no objection to the proposal. Details regarding treatment location and type can be discussed and concurred on prior to installation. A review for the 40k HPAA can be undertaken, but will need to meet the relevant requirements in order to be approved.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the:

- A. The installation of the Threshold Treatment by the developer of 91-93 McIntosh Road, Narraweena at no cost to Council.
- B. Council obtain TfNSW technical advice prior to the implementation of the device.
- C. After the installation of the Threshold at Alfred Street, the Transport for New South Wales to review the speed limit to bring it down to 40km/h High Pedestrian Activity Area between the proposed threshold and the existing raised pedestrian crossing.

4.19 GROVER AVENUE & CARRINGTON AVENUE, CROMER - NO LEFT TURN (VEHICLES UNDER 9M EXCEPTED)
