Answer:

Council recognises the need for improved skate park facilities. The current priority is for a major overhaul and expansion of the existing skate park at Kitchener Park, Mona Vale. The expanded facility at Kitchener Park is intended to cater for a range of activities including BMX bike riding, skating and will include additional elements such as a street course.

Narroy Park may be a good location for an additional smaller skate park in the southern part of the Pittwater LGA and the Scouts are encouraged to provide a more detailed submission to Council for further consideration.
