### **REPORT**

#### **BACKGROUND**

Due to an upcoming temporary closure of Nandi Avenue, Frenchs Forest, it is expected that vehicles will be diverted through Bimbadeen Crescent to exit this area. Council is proposing to have a temporary parking restriction along the northern side of Bimbadeen Crescent, between Nandi Avenue and Ilford Road, to maintain the two way traffic and improve the visibility for the vehicles from the opposite direction. This proposal will only be retained until the re-opening of Nandi Avenue.

#### **LOCATION**

- Bimbadeen Crescent is a local road with a 50km/h speed limit.
- The section of the road under consideration has a variable pavement width between 6.5m and 7m with a kerb and gutter on both sides of the road.
- There are difficulties for drivers to pass each other if the vehicles are parked on both sides of the road.

#### **ISSUES**

- When the vehicles are parked on both sides of the road drivers find it difficult to pass each other, particularly with increase in traffic.
- This proposal is temporary to improve the traffic flow during the closure of Nandi Avenue and is expected to end in July 2018.

#### **CONSULTATION**

All the residents within approximately 50m radius of the proposed location will be notified of the change. There will be no consultation due to the short nature and quick turn-around time of the proposal.

## **REPORT**

### **BACKGROUND**

Council has received concerns from impacted businesses on Patanga Road, Frenchs Forest, regarding a loss of short-term parking due to the construction at the corner of Patanga Road and Frenches Forest Road East. There were approximately 20 one-hour car spaces at the corner of Patanga Road and Frenches Forest Road East that are now under construction. In response, Council is proposing to provide temporary 3-hour parking spaces on both sides of the Patanga Road, between Frenches Forest Road East and Dareen Street, until the construction is finished. The bus stop in front of Patanga Park will also be temporarily closed and passengers will be redirected to the Bus Stop 100m North in front of 20 Patanga Road, Frenchs Forest.

### **LOCATION**

- The section of the road under consideration has a variable pavement width between 9.5m and 10m allowing two-way traffic with on-street parking on both sides of the road.
- There are a few shops and cafes that depend on the availability of short-term parking spaces for their customers.

### **ISSUES**

- Local shops are impacted from the construction in front of their businesses. It was identified that additional short term parking would assist these businesses.
- There are two Bus Stops for the same route within 100m on Patanga Road. The Bus Stop in front of Patanga Park will be temporarily closed to provide a few extra parking spaces at this location.

### **CONSULTATION**

All the residents within approximately 50m radius of the proposed location will be notified of the change. There will be no consultation due to the short nature and quick turn-around time of the proposal.

### **RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE**

That the Traffic Committee supports:

- A. The temporary installation of 3P 6:00am-6:00pm Mon-Sat on both sides of the Patanga Road, between Frenches Forest Road East and Dareen Street, Frenchs Forest, until the construction is finished.
  - B. The temporary closure of the Bus Stop in front of Patanga Park, Frenchs Forest, until the construction is finished.
