2.0 DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY AND CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Members are advised of the following definitions of a "pecuniary" or "conflict" of interest for their assistance:

Section 442 of the Local Government Act, 1993 states that a "pecuniary" interest is as follows:

- "(1) [Pecuniary interest] A Pecuniary interest is an interest that a person has in a matter because of a reasonable likelihood or expectation of appreciable financial gain or loss to the person or another person with whom the person is associated.
- (2) [Remoteness] A person does not have a pecuniary interest in a matter if the interest is so remote or insignificant that it could not reasonably be regarded as likely to influence any decision the person might make in relation to the matter."

Members should reference the Local Government Act, 1993 for detailed provisions relating to pecuniary interests.

Council's Code of Conduct states that a "conflict of interest" exists when you could be influenced, or a reasonable person would perceive that you could be influenced by a personal interest when carrying out your public duty.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

PURPOSE

To provide a further opportunity for the Strategic Reference Group (SRG) stakeholders to provide their input into the development of the Northern Beaches Environment Strategy, particularly its framework, key themes and ambition.

SUMMARY/REPORT

This workshop provides follow-up and builds upon the approach and directions identified in the workshop of 12 April to develop the Northern Beaches Environment Strategy.

The previous workshop identified that the strategy should be:

"Evidence based, Innovative, Leading, Sustainable, Courageous, Inclusive and Creative"

...and it should include and feel:

"Accessible, Linked to community, Educational, Evidence Based, Contextual, Measurable and Action Based"

During the workshop we will consider the proposed framework and associated key themes of the strategy.

The current baselines for the data intensive areas of carbon emissions and water use which have recently been compiled for 2016/17 will be presented to the SRG. We will then use these key areas to seek further input from the SRG around setting the context for, and testing the impacts of, how ambitious, evidence based and leading the strategy should be.
