4.1 QUIRK ROAD, BALGOWLAH - TIMED PARKING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports:

- A. The introduction of an 8P parking restriction applying 8:30am to 6:00pm Mon-Fri over the full length of the eastern side of Quirk Road, Balgowlah.
- B. Retaining the existing 90° angle parking front to kerb restriction on the eastern side of Quirk Road, Balgowlah.

Council Decision – Approved

4.2 ROOSEVELT AVENUE, ALLAMBIE HEIGHTS - NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports:

- A. Removing the '5P (8:00am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm, School Days)' parking restriction on the northern side of Roosevelt Avenue, Allambie Heights, and replacing it with 'No Parking (8:00am to 9:30am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm, School Days)' and 'No Stopping' at other times.
- B. Introducing an 8m length of 'No Stopping' restrictions midway along the No Parking zone adjacent to the school gates.

Council Decision - Approved

4.3 CROMER PARK, SOUTH CREEK ROAD, CROMER - NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the installation of 'No Parking' restrictions on either side of the driveway at Cromer Park's small carpark, South Creek Road, Cromer.

Council Decision - Approved



4.4 HILLCREST AVENUE, MONA VALE - NO PARKING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the installation of No Parking restrictions on each side of the crossing point at Hillcrest Avenue, Mona Vale.

Council Decision - Approved

4.5 JOCELYN LANE, NORTH CURL CURL - NO PARKING AND NO STOPPING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports:

- A. The installation of 'No Parking' signs on both sides of Jocelyn Lane, North Curl Curl.
- B. The installation of 10m statutory 'No Stopping' signs at all corners of Jocelyn Street and Jocelyn Lane intersection.
- C. The installation of 10m statutory 'No Stopping' signs at all corners of Headland Road and Jocelyn Lane intersection.

Council Decision - Approved

4.6 FROMELLES AVENUE, SEAFORTH - NO STOPPING RESTRICTIONS

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the extension of the existing No Stopping zone on the east side of Fromelles Avenue, Seaforth, by 10m in a northerly direction so that it terminates at the first driveway north of Montauban Avenue, Seaforth.

Council Decision - Approved



4.7 WARRIEWOOD ROAD, WARRIEWOOD - SIGNAGE AND LINE MARKING PLAN FOR THE PROPOSED SUBDIVISION

PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The RMS Representative stated that on page two of the plan the 'No Stopping' sign that is west of the roundabout (on Warriewood Road and Hill Street, Warriewood) at the first intersection on the north side of the road, should indicate 'No Stopping' in both directions rather than a right arrow only. Council will contact the Developer to have this amended.

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the plan for the Signs and Line marking (with the adjustment of the 'No Stopping' sign to point in both directions) for the proposed residential Subdivision at 23-27 Warriewood Road, Warriewood.

Council Decision – Approved

5.0 MATTERS FOR NOTATION

- 5.1 The Manly MP Representative stated that he received a complaint from a resident regarding excessive speed on Adams Street, Curl Curl. The resident requested the implementation of traffic calming devices. Council will investigate and report back at the next Northern Beaches Council Local Traffic Committee meeting.
- 5.2 The Acting Executive Manager of Transport and Civil Infrastructure raised the matter of McCarrs Creek Road, Church Point, and the illegal speed hump and signage that was installed by a member of the public recently. Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be installed this week with "Share the Road" and speed messages. No traffic calming devices will be installed at this point. Speed humps are not safe for cyclists and also create further noise issues. Sergeant Jelovic advised that there was an ongoing Police operation and patrol of the road and residents can call the Police if they see any illegal activity.
