#### 4.1 WANAWONG ROAD, AVALON BEACH - INTERSECTION TREATMENT

#### PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

#### RECOMMENDATION TO COUNCIL

That the Traffic Committee supports the installation of a give way sign, a dividing barrier line and associated line markings on Wanawong Road intersection with Wandearah Avenue, Avalon Beach.

**Council Decision – Approved** 

#### 4.2 WHISTLER STREET, MANLY - KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS

#### **PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF**

The RMS Representative confirmed that Keep Clear and Do Not Queue Across intersection signs are to be installed by RMS at the request of Council. It was discussed and agreed upon that these signs and markings should also be installed across the entry point to the Whistler Street parking station.

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

#### RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee notes that Council will write to the Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) and request the installation of Keep Clear markings and G9-237 Do Not Queue Across Intersection signage on Whistler Street, Manly, across the entry and exit points from the Whistler Street parking station.

#### 4.3 BOONDAH ROAD, WARRIEWOOD - TIMED PARKING RESTRICTIONS

#### PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

#### RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the proposal to install '5P 8:30am-6:00pm Everyday' restrictions in Boondah Road (both sides), Warriewood, between the second raised pedestrian crossing and Narrabeen Creek.

**Council Decision - Approved** 

#### 4.4 COBB STREET AND SYLVIA PLACE, FRENCHS FOREST - PARKING RESTRICTIONS

#### PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

#### **RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE**

That the Traffic Committee supports the installation of dividing barrier lines on Cobb Street and Sylvia Place for 20m from the intersections with Frenchs Forest Road West, Frenchs Forest.

#### **Council Decision - Approved**



### 4.5 192 AVALON TO STOKES POINT (LOOP SERVICE), AVALON BEACH - BUS ROUTE IMPROVEMENTS

#### PROCEEDINGS IN BRIEF

Mr Terry Paradine addressed the Traffic Committee on behalf of the George Street Residents Group opposing the rerouting of Bus 192 from Patrick Street to George Street, Avalon Beach, and supporting Option 1:

- Option 1: Existing Patrick Street Route - Proposed 'No Parking 7:00am-5:00pm Everyday' restrictions

Proposed 'No Parking 7:00am-5:00pm Everyday' restrictions on one side of the road, between Therry Street and Joseph Street (southbound) and Bus Zone restrictions to formalise existing bus stop. Nett loss of ten on-street car park spaces.

The concerns of the George Street Residents Group, of 100 members, include an increase in noise and pollution, less on-street parking, devaluation of property and public safety risks posed by the narrow sections of George Street. Mr Terry Paradine tabled a petition signed by over 90% of impacted George Street residents.

The STA Representative preferred the George Street options. If Option 1 was the agreed recommendation he requested an extension of the timed parking restrictions, particularly in the evenings, due to bus driver complaints. It was agreed to implement Option 1 and monitor the current parking restrictions and review if any issues. The STA Representative agreed to this.

The Committee concurred with the recommendation.

#### RECOMMENDATION TO TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

That the Traffic Committee supports the following changes in Patrick Street, between Therry Street and Joseph Street, Avalon Beach, to improve safety and access along the 192 Avalon to Stokes Point (Loop Service); noting the petition submitted by the George Street Residents Group:

- A. Installation of statutory 10m 'No Stopping' restrictions at the north-east corner of Patrick Street and Joseph Street.
- B. Installation of Bus Zone restrictions 20m from the 'No Stopping' restrictions.
- C. Installation of 'No Parking 7:00am-5:00pm Everyday' restrictions, from south of the driveway to No.62 Patrick Street to the start of the new Bus Zone.
