About this guide

Manly is a popular destination, with beautiful beaches and an impressive collection of world-class restaurants, bars and shops.

The best way to visit Manly is by public transport. It's not only a cheaper alternative to driving but also reduces traffic and pollution. You don't need to worry about finding a parking space and can take your time to enjoy a swim, coffee or long lunch in one of the local restaurants.

Manly is serviced by a number of buses which travel from Palm Beach, Sydney City, North Sydney and St Leonards, to name a few. Ferries run to Circular Quay and Barangaroo. Visit transportnsw.info for information on bus and ferry timetables.

Cycling

There is secure bicycle parking in Whistler Street carpark, Manly. The cost is \$61 per year. This includes access to a bicycle repair kit inside. There are also bicycle racks in front of Manly Wharf.

Parking stations

Permanent paid parking spaces are available in allocated Council stations, with options available between 2-7 days, varying from \$86.70 - \$346.70 per month.

General parking in Council's four stations open from 6:30am-midnight:

- Manly National** Central Avenue, Manly. Height restriction: 1.95m
EARLY BIRD Monday to Friday only - \$21.50 (entry before 9am and exit after 3pm)
- Pacific Waves** Central Avenue, Manly. Height restriction: 2m
- Peninsula** Wentworth Street, Manly. Height restriction: 2.1m
- Whistler** Whistler Street, Manly. Height restriction: 2m (plus two loading zones by exit gate)

Daytime fee

Entry between
6.30am - 6.59pm

0 - 2 hours*	Free
2 - 2.5 hours	\$10
2.5 - 3 hours	\$13
3 - 3.5 hours	\$16
3.5 - 4 hours	\$20
4 - 5 hours	\$32
5 + hours	\$43

*Re-entering or visiting another Northern Beaches Council carpark within 3 hours of exiting will incur fees starting at 2 – 2.5 hourly rate, regardless of the duration of your original stay.

Evening fee

Entry after 7pm

\$5 flat fee

*Please note – there is no free period

Overnight fee

\$5 additional charge for vehicles remaining in the carpark after 12am.

Two commercial carparks also exist under Quest Hotel (2.1m) and Manly Wharf (1.9m).

Operational Commercial Vehicle Top Up Card

\$25 flat fee per weekend day for those that require a vehicle for operational purposes and work within 1 km of Manly National carpark. This is not for those who require parking for commuting.

Hop Skip Jump

Council's free community bus service operates seven days per week, 8:30am to approximately 5.30pm through the suburbs of Manly, Fairlight, Balgowlah, Balgowlah Heights, Clontarf and Seaforth. There is unlimited street parking available on sections of each route.

Ride Plus

The Ride Plus trial, runs two shuttle busses which customers can access via the booking app.

Ride Plus collects you from your door, dropping users to specific, major transport hubs (like Manly Wharf) for \$3.10 per trip. The service operates Monday to Friday – 6am to 10pm, except public holidays.

Area permit scheme

Parking permit schemes were introduced around Manly CBD to give priority to residents for on-street parking near their homes.

The following parking schemes operate:

Balgowlah	Valid 1 February to 31 January
Ethel Street	Valid 1 June to 31 May
Fairy Bower	Valid 1 July to 30 June
Ivanhoe Park	Valid 1 July to 30 June
Ivanhoe Park Extension	Valid 2 August to 1 August
Little Manly	Valid 1 February to 31 January
Ocean Beach	Valid 1 April to 31 March
The Isthmus	Valid 1 July to 30 June
Tower Hill	Valid 1 July to 30 June
Tower Hill Extension	Valid 1 March to 28 February

Timed parking

There are timed parking zones around Manly town centre including 30 minute, 2 and 4 hours.

Beach permit sticker

Residents and ratepayers displaying a Northern Beaches Council beach parking permit sticker have free parking at more than 40 Northern Beaches' locations.

Manly's beachfront pay and display parking spaces along North and South Steyne are limited to four hours free parking, when your beach parking permit is displayed.

Pre-paid parking PCYC carpark, Dee Why

There is pre-paid parking offered on a short and long term basis at PCYC carpark, 40 Kingsway, Dee Why. The carpark is open from 5.30am – midnight Monday – Saturday and 6.30am – midnight Sundays and public holidays. It is a secure carpark and is locked shut every night.

There is a B-Line stop with buses that service the Northern beaches including Manly.

The casual fees are:

Up to 3 hours per day*:	Free
3 - 4 hours	\$3
4 - 5 hours	\$4
5 hours +	\$5

*Vehicles re-entering after using their 3 hours free parking will incur fees starting at 3-4 hour rate.

Park&Ride – B-Line Buses

To qualify for free Transport Park&Ride parking, you must:

- Be the holder of a valid Adult, Child/Youth, Gold Senior/ Pensioner or Concession Opal card
- Park in a dedicated Transport Park&Ride car park
- Tap on and tap off with your Opal card to complete a trip on public transport
- Use the same Opal card to tap out of the car park within 18 hours of entering

There are Transport Park&Ride car parks at Balgowlah and Manly Vale where the 199 bus goes straight into Manly.

Motorcycle parking

Motorcycles can park for free in the designated motorcycle parking areas in the Manly parking stations. Any motorcycles parking in a vehicle bay are subject to the full fees and charges. Fines may apply to any motorcycles parked in a vehicle bay that exits without paying.

Motorcycles parked in a pay and display bay or permit zone must display either a valid parking permit or a pay and display ticket.

Accessible parking

Visitors with a valid mobility parking permit may park for free at any pay and display council carpark.

They are also able to park in any timed bay of over 30 minutes for an unlimited amount of time. Please refer to RMS guidelines.

Mobility permit holders are still subject to the same fees and charges in the Manly pay stations (those car parks operated behind a boom gate).
