



A Message from the Mayor



Northern Beaches Council will benefit from an additional \$21.1 million funding from the NSW Government for a range of high priority community projects as part of the Government's continued commitment to support new councils.

The 11 projects include buying 'Pasadena' at Church Point and converting it into a community park; a regional performing arts centre at Mona Vale Public School, a performance space and amphitheatre at Barrenjoey High School and several surf club refurbishments.

Other important projects include the much-needed flood mitigation on Wakehurst Parkway, heritage refurbishments at Currarong Beach, a wastewater feasibility study for Scotland Island, permanent netball courts in Avalon and foreshore improvements at Palm Beach, Clareville and Careel Bay.

This funding builds on the earlier \$28.6m funding from the NSW government to deliver the Palm Beach to Manly walkway and the extensive cycleway and shared path network focussed on the B-Line, as well as vital funding support to 53 worthwhile community-run projects.

Australia Day might still be three months away but I want to take this opportunity to encourage the community to nominate citizens for Australia Day Awards. If you know someone who deserves this special accolade, please go to Council's website to nominate them by 27 November.

I also encourage you to get involved in helping set Council's service delivery priorities for the next three years. Get involved in this important process because your input will shape our roadmap for the future. Details of the consultation workshops can be found on page 16 and at our website.

And finally, I hope you can attend today's Brookie Show. With a circus theme and featuring highlights such as aerial acrobatics, live music, delicious street food and a 7.45pm firework spectacular – there really is something for everyone. Come along and don't forget to bring your refillable water bottles because there will be no plastic water bottles being sold as we strive to reduce plastic pollution on the Northern Beaches.
