Re-establishment of Manly Alcohol Free Zone (AFZ)

We're re-establishing the existing AFZ in the following area for a further four years to take effect from Sat 7 Jul:

The area bounded by North Steyne and South Steyne, Ashburner St, East and West Esplanade, Eustace St, Pittwater Rd and Steinton St, Manly.

An AFZ is used as an early intervention measure to prevent the escalation of irresponsible street drinking, which can lead to more serious crime. The AFZ applies to public roads, footpaths and public carparks and is in force 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
