Firstly, some exciting news about cheaper night parking in Manly. We all know what a fantastic place Manly is for dining and entertainment after dark but one of the common issues residents raise is how much parking can add to the cost of a great night out.

So from this week, Council has dropped our evening parking flat rate to just \$5 after 7pm in all four of Council's parking stations in the Manly CBD. Plus, for an additional \$5 you can leave the car there overnight and not attract any additional charges until 8.30am the next day. This is down from the previous \$50 fee!

Manly has a vibrant after-dark culture and we're sure this initiative will not only benefit residents and visitors but will mean even more people will support Manly's great businesses.

Draft Councillor Expenses and Facilities Policy

Our draft policy, required under s252(1) of the Local Government Act 1993, provides guidelines for paying expenses and providing facilities to the mayor, deputy mayor and councillors to assist them in their roles and civic duties.

Widening of Manly Alcohol Free Zone (AFZ)

As a result of the consultation process for the recent re-establishment of the Manly AFZ to 2022, the need to widen the zone became apparent. The existing area is bounded by North Steyne and South Steyne, Ashburner St, East and West Esplanade, Eustace St, Pittwater Rd and Steinton St.

The proposed widening of the AFZ includes the streets around Manly Oval and Ivanhoe Park bounded by and including Raglan St, Park Ave and Sydney Rd to Birkley Rd.

AFZs are used as an early intervention tool to prevent the escalation of irresponsible street drinking which can lead to incidents involving serious crime. An AFZ applies to public roads, footpaths and public carparks and applies 24 hours a day, seven days per week.
