This week, to mark NAIDOC Week and as part of the 2018 Gai-mariagal

Festival, over 150 woven art pieces were installed on the Stuart Somerville Bridge at Queenscliff.

The art display is the result of a community project where people shared stories and creativity during weaving workshops under the guidance of Northern Beaches Aboriginal artists.

It's an impressive sight as you walk over the bridge - I encourage you to have a look.
