Young Jack has inspired me to do something too, and throughout next week we'll be encouraging all Council staff to dig deep and contribute to his campaign. I've been fielding some questions this week about what Council is doing to support residents who want to compost their food waste following the latest episode of ABC's War on Waste. You'll be pleased to know we've got something in the pipeline which will be rolled out mid-next year. New technology means that food going into the general waste bin will be able to be processed, the organics separated and used to produce compost for use in broad-acre agriculture and mine site revegetation.

It will make sure the maximum amount of organic waste is recovered without any need for you to separate it at the source, and will also ensure that the products made from our excellent garden vegetation recycling is not compromised. We're expecting it will take our waste diversion rate from around 50% currently to over 70%. We'll have more information in the coming months. Stay tuned!

Next Friday marks Vietnam Veterans Day. This day honours the 108 Australian and New Zealand diggers who fought in a fierce battle against over 2,000 North Vietnamese and Viet Cong troops in a rubber plantation not far from the small village of Long Tan in 1966. Fortunately the Australians prevailed, but like most wars at a cost to human life – 18 Australians lost their lives and 24 were wounded. Lest we forget. I will be attending a commemorative service at the War Memorial in Manly to mark my respects.

These reserves will be closed to dogs and cats until Mon 8 Oct:

*Foxoff® Econobait® poison baits will be laid between Mon 20 Aug

and Mon 10 Sep. These baits are specifically designed for fox control and contain 1080 (sodium monofluoroacetate). Warning signs will be displayed.

We're conducting this program with the National Parks and Wildlife Service. Native animals at risk from foxes include bandicoots, possums, wallabies, bush rats and brush turkeys.
