These reserves will be closed to dogs and cats until Mon 8 Oct:

'Foxoff® Econobait' poison baits will be laid between Mon 20 Aug and Mon 10 Sep. These baits are specifically designed for fox control and contain 1080 (sodium monofluoroacetate). Warning signs will be displayed.

We're conducting this program with the National Parks and Wildlife Service. Native animals at risk from foxes include bandicoots, possums, wallabies, bush rats and brush turkeys.
