

## A Message from the Mayor



We know that here on the Northern Beaches we have a community who are very passionate about our environment. We are avid recyclers, we strive to remember our reusable coffee cups and shopping bags, and increasing numbers of us have garden compost and worm farms.

Council's new household waste service will support the war on waste, diverting more of our waste from landfill and avoiding the equivalent of 42,300 tonnes of carbon dioxide each year – like taking more than 8,400 cars off the road.

And it won't just be greener but also cleaner. Our fleet of brand new high-tech waste trucks will further reduce carbon emissions, are safer and are fully enclosed to prevent any litter or odours.

Our new waste service uses the latest in smart technology. Residents will be able to track their own waste service using an app and at Council we'll be able to track every service and demand greater accountability from our collection contractors. That means a better service for our whole community.

The new contract will not just improve service levels and provide good environmental outcomes, but will also deliver savings that will be passed on to ratepayers.

The new waste service starts on 1 July. In preparation, over the next few months we are undertaking the biggest bin delivery and take back program ever undertaken in Australia.

The program will replace our ageing stock of residential bins with new smart bins and recycle one hundred per cent of collected bins.

This is a significant logistical exercise, rolling out 330,000 new bins to around 100,000 residents. You'll be receiving more information in the coming weeks as to when to expect your new bins and how to make sure your old ones are collected.

Finally, a reminder that the Seniors Festival is now in full swing. Plenty to interest everyone with a selection of workshops, events and activities, book in now. You'll find the full program on our website.
