

A message from the Mayor



Council's new waste service is getting close to kick off on 1 July. Please check your new waste calendar or our website to find out more about your new bin collection days.

I'm happy to report that more than 184,000 old bins have already been sent off to be recycled into new ones. Since it costs more to replace and repair them in an ad hoc way over the 10-year contract, ratepayers will save around \$1.2million over the longer term if we replace them now. In fact the bins we picked up a few months ago from Avalon and Palm Beach have been recycled into bins being delivered now to Allambie Heights and Duffys Forest!

You may have read that there have been some instances where bins have inadvertently made their way to Kimbriki instead of our recycling plant. While a small number of bins appear to have been involved, our partners have put additional measures in place to further reduce the chance of this happening as the project wraps up.

Elsewhere, a gentle reminder that entries close for the Northern Beaches Art Prize this coming Monday at 5pm. It's the area's most prestigious art competition, offering total prizes worth \$27,000 across four categories. Make sure you don't miss out.

Entries are also now open for the 2019 Young Writers' Competition. Encourage your budding young Shakespeare to apply - competition is open to students in Kindergarten through to Year 12.

And with year 12 exams rapidly approaching, students can get a lot from Council's Secrets of HSC Success lecture series. The first is on Monday at Warringah Mall Library, with student Caroline Wang. Caroline achieved an impressive ATAR of 97.50 and she will share how she learnt to study smarter, not harder.

Finally, a shout out to all our committed staff who were recognised at the annual NSW Local Government Excellence Awards this week. Congrats to our library team who scooped up two awards and a special mention for the cross-Council team that won the highly coveted Australasian Management Challenge. Great work all.




