Celebrations for NAIDOC Week have been occurring around the country including with our own staff acknowledging the significance with a flag raising ceremony at Dee Why Civic Centre on Monday morning with a representative of our local Aboriginal Heritage Office.

NAIDOC Week celebrates Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander history, culture and achievements and this year's theme includes Truth, Voice and Treaty.

To mark NAIDOC, and the month-long Gai-mariagal Festival which winds up this week, we also launched the spectacular Weaving Bridges project on Queenscliff Bridge. This project involves months of workshops with local Aboriginal Elders, creating woven pieces that combine to create an incredible colourful artwork across the bridge. It will be up for the next week or so - make sure you get down to see it.

I know of many people across our area who have taken on the Plastic Free July challenge and are finding creative ways to avoid plastic. The challenge has grown from what was once a humble office initiative in Perth into a global movement, with over two million people in 170 countries taking part annually.

Whether you do the challenge or not, check out the great array of Council waste reduction workshops and take the Swap This for That pledge to replace your plastic bags, water bottles, straws, and coffee cups with reusable alternatives.

You can't miss the message on our new colourful waste trucks too, helping to spread a mobile reminder for our community and visitors to avoid single use plastics.

Finally, if you are stuck without something for the kids to do next, we've got you covered. Proposed lease of road reserve adjacent to 4 The Avenue, Newport

Under s154 of the Roads Act 1993, we're considering a lease for a term of five years to the owner of 4 The Avenue (Lot 2 DP 1059003) for approximately 38m² of road reserve.

The purpose of the proposed lease is for parking motor vehicles and/or boat storage.

Proposed easement to drain water at Toongari Reserve, Avalon Pde, Avalon Beach

Under s47 of the Local Government Act 1993, we're considering granting an easement (2m wide and approximately 5m in length) to drain water over part of Council community land (Lot 102 DP 785848) to the owners of 69 & 71 Central Rd, Avalon Beach (Lot 15 & 16 DP 8698).

The purpose of formalising an easement is to enable the construction of an underground stormwater drainage pipe within Toongari Reserve. The proposed easement is to be granted in perpetuity.

The granting of the proposed easement is subject to Council approval and payment to Council of an independently assessed value of compensation.
