



## A message from the Mayor



I have been sincerely moved this week to see the generous response of the Australian people to the devastating bushfires and ongoing drought.

I am in awe of how our community has found ways to help others at this time. Council is also doing its bit to help the bushfire recovery effort in various ways.

We are donating all profits from the Sun Run on Saturday 1 February to WIRES. Runners can make an additional donation at the time of registration, so if you haven't already registered jump online and please dig deep.

Throughout our summer events including Christmas concerts, New Years Eve and last weekend's popular Outdoor Cinema, we have been working with Rotary and the RFS who together have collected almost \$9,000 in community donations.

Council, along with staff also supported Avalon Surf Life Saving Club's appeal by donating essential supplies like ventilation masks and air mattresses, along with 168,000 litres of drinking water that was delivered to a dozen families on the south coast.

Over the holiday period, we also had the privilege of hosting four families from drought-affected Mullaley, just west of our sister city Gunnedah, at Manly Beach. Royal Far West, along with some of our generous local businesses and Council, helped these families have a few days respite from their tough lives.

We all welcome the sweet relief of rain and cooler temperatures that finally paid us a visit this week.

Still, with water supplies in Sydney at such a low, Council is also working with Sydney Water in a bid to help residents and businesses reduce our water use. Find out how you can do your bit at Sydney Water's website.

January on the Beaches is all about beach swims, school holidays, Australia Day, and the launch of Northern Composure - the largest and longest-running youth band competition in the area.

Entrants will get a chance to take part in workshops, perform on stage to an audience and gain local exposure for their talents. 
