Local Heritage Fund grants

Grant applications for 2019/2020 are now open.

Our Local Heritage Fund offers small grants to owners of heritage items for projects which help to conserve the heritage values of buildings and other items of heritage significance listed in Schedule 5 of the Manly, Pittwater and Warringah Local Environmental Plans. Eligible projects may be offered grants of between \$200 and \$3000, not exceeding 50% of the project cost. Works must be approved and completed before applying for a grant.
